Junior Year College Advisory Program



- 1. Review your records and present year courses with your guidance counselor. Make tentative plans your senior year schedule**
- 2. Set and maintain goals for grades in all junior year courses as well as SAT scores**
- 3. Continue development of “Student Activity Resume” based on your co-curricular and volunteer activities**
- 4. Take the PSAT’s in October**
- 5. Review PSAT results with your counselor and teachers. Prepare for takings the SAT at least once during second semester junior year.**
- 6. Register with CollegeBoard.com with your guidance counselor.**
- 7. Discuss plans for after high school and use a college search program to establish a list of colleges to apply to senior year.**
- 8. Attend one or more college open houses and information sessions during the spring of junior year.**
- 9. Become aware of the NCAA GPA and SAT requirements for Division I, II and III for anyone looking to participate in college athletics**
- 10. Register for the SAT’s on CollegeBoard.com and take the SAT’s during January, March, May and/or June. Discuss your options with your Guidance Counselor.**
