### **Senior Year College Advisory Program**



- 1. Meet with your guidance counselor to: review records, set academic goals, complete senior intake interview, develop a personal senior year calendar**
- 2. Register for the October/November SAT test.**
- 3. Complete development of “Student Activity Resume.” Type in final form and review with guidance counselor.**
- 4. Sign-up to meet college representatives in the library**
- 5. Finalize colleges and universities you will apply to this year. Make a list including application due date, financial aid due date, and date by which you plan to apply.**
- 6. Visit colleges on Open House dates and/or through Campus Tours. Also plan to attend the Middlesex County college fair in October**
- 7. Complete the NCAA Clearinghouse form online if planning on playing sports in college.**
- 8. Use the College Board website to search for available scholarships.**
- 9. In January, apply for financial aid using the FAFSA form.**
- 10. Coordinate response letters from colleges along with financial aid awards. Use this to make a final college decision in discussion with parents/guardians.**
